I have attached a copy of my addendum report for the aforementioned project and sent a copy to Raymus Homes. The effort was based on the Mitigation Monitoring Recommendation 4.4-3 (after EDAW's investigation report recommendation (Deis 2006:22). Results of the investigation were negative. Further, I saw nothing in my examination of modern and historical aerial photographs and the historical soil survey that would suggest the two parcel subject to my study were any more archaeologically sensitive than most other areas south of Manteca not adjacent or close to historical or modern watercourses. As indicated by EDAW, there is always a possibility of discovering buried cultural resources because the project is within an alluvial environment subject to historical flooding. I suggest following Mitigation Monitoring Recommendation 4.4-4 to address this issue.
