

## **RESOLUTION NO. R2007-372**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA CERTIFYING THE 2005 WATER MASTER PLAN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT AND ASSOCIATED DOCUMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Manteca, at a meeting held May 7, 2007, held a duly advertised and noticed public hearing on the 2005 Water Master Plan Environmental Impact Report; and

**WHEREAS**, at the duly advertised public hearing, the City Council received testimony supporting and opposing the Environmental Impact Report from those interested parties; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the final Environmental Impact Report has been completed in compliance with CEQA, California Environmental Quality Act as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council independently reviewed and considered the information contained in the final Environmental Impact Report prior to approving the project entitlements; and

**WHEREAS**, the environmental impact report identifies one or more significant environmental effects and the City Council has reviewed and adopted written findings for each significant effect accompanied by a brief explanation of the rationale for each finding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the City of Council of the City of Manteca that it does hereby take the following action:

- ◆ Certify the 2005 Water Master Plan Environmental Impact Report has been prepared in compliance with CEQA;
- ◆ Approve the Findings of Fact and Statement of Overriding Considerations for the 2005 Water Master Plan Environmental Impact Report, on file in the Community Development Department, that the benefits associated with implementation of the 2005 Water Master Plan will outweigh the negative and unmitigatable impacts on agricultural resources, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, hydrology/water quality resources, noise, transportation and circulation, utilities and service systems;
- ◆ Adopt the 2005 Water Master Plan Mitigation Monitoring Program (on file in the Community Development Department); and

- ◆ Finds that the Project Alternatives to the 2005 Water Master Plan are all infeasible and Findings of Fact and Statement of Overriding Considerations are adopted.


